

People in Jesus' Life

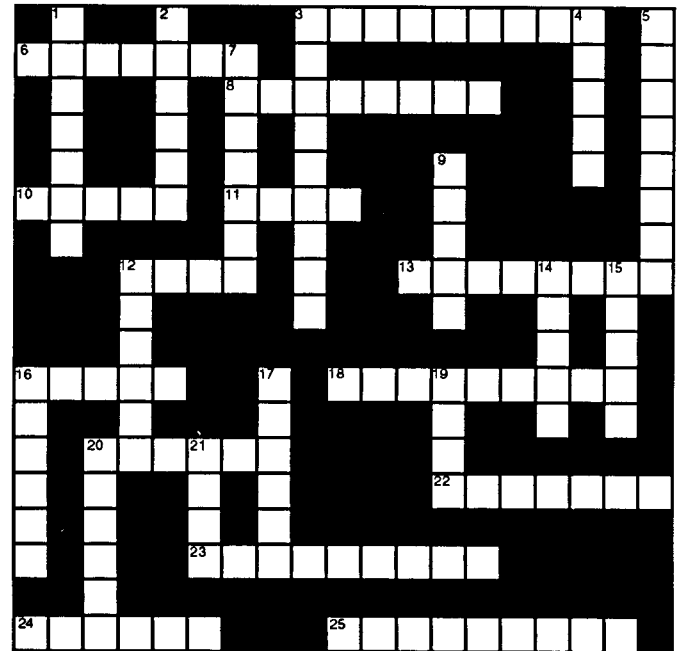

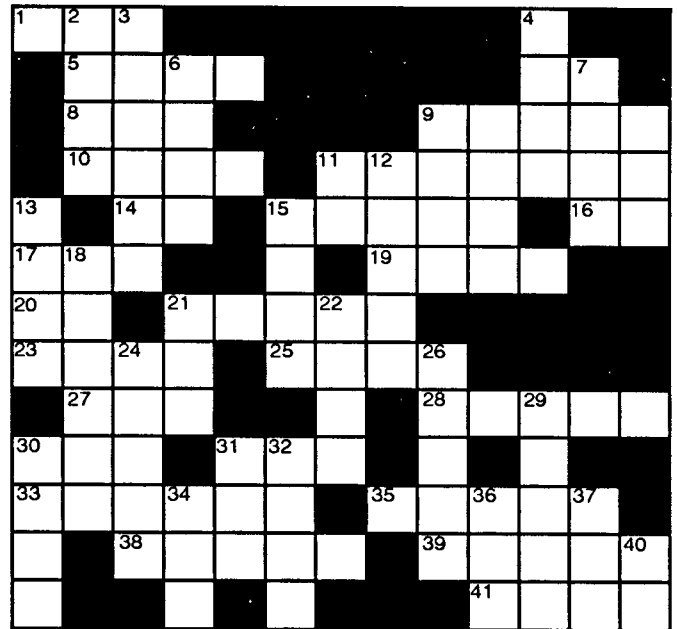
