



Let's Make And Learn!

GOD MADE ME PLAQUE



What You Need:

Four Popsicle or craft sticks for each child
Pastel-colored construction paper
Felt tip pen
Rubber stamp ink pad and ink

Glue or paste
Scissors
Damp paper towels
Yarn
Strapping tape



How To Make It:

1. Before class time, cut a 4 1/2-inch square of pastel construction paper for each child.
2. Have each child write her name and the following words on a construction paper square: "God made me. I am His child."
3. The children will glue the craft sticks around the edges of the construction paper to form a frame. Allow the glue to dry.
4. The children will then carefully place their fingers on the ink pad and make fingerprints on the construction paper. Use the damp paper towels to clean the ink off little hands.
5. The children may tape a loop of yarn to the back of the plaque for hanging.
6. Discuss the differences between the various fingerprints. Remind the children that there is no one else exactly like them, because God made them very special!
