## (Daniel 1:1-20 continued)

Daniel then said to the guard . . . , "Please test [us] for ten days: Give us nothing but vegetables to eat and water to drink. Then compare our appearance with that of the young men who eat the royal food, and treat [us] in accordance with what you see." So he agreed to this and tested them for ten days.

At the end of the ten days they looked healthier and better nourished than any of the young men who ate the royal food. So the guard took away their choice food . . . and gave them vegetables instead.

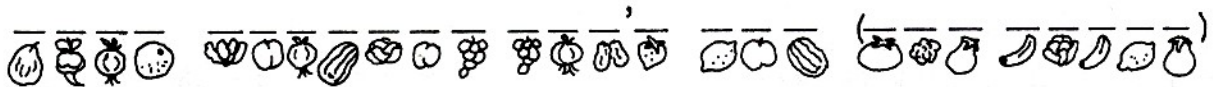
To these four young men God gave knowledge and understanding of all kinds of literature and learning. And Daniel could understand visions and dreams of all kinds.

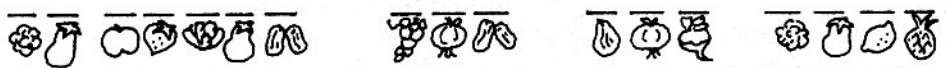
Daniel and his three friends had been taught about God and what the Bible says is right. When they had to make a choice, they knew what God would want them to do. Daniel made a wise choice.


















### Can you find the answers to these questions by using the fruit and veggie code?
