



Let's Make And Learn!

FRIENDSHIP KITE



What You Need:

Felt scraps (white and brightly colored)

Hole punch

Sequins (multi-colored)

Scissors

Glue

Rug yarn (black and colored)

Large safety pin

Colored markers

Needle and thread



How To Make It:

1. Cut a 2-inch diamond shape of colored felt for each child. Punch a hole in one corner. Tie a 6-inch length of black rug yarn, doubled to 3 inches in length, through the hole in the corner of the felt so the piece resembles a kite.
2. Children will decorate their kites by gluing sequins to the felt.
3. Each child should then cut 2-inch lengths of different colored yarn (one piece each to represent a good friend), and tie these to the tail of his kite.
4. Cut a cloud shape from the white felt. Be sure that it is larger than the kite.
5. Glue the kite onto the cloud and use a marker to print the Bible verse on the cloud. (Or glue a strip of paper, on which the Bible verse has been printed, to the cloud.)
6. A safety pin should be stitched to the back of each cloud so the children can wear their Friendship Kites.
