RAINBOW WIND CHIME



What You Need:

Cardboard paper towel tube
Tongue depressors
Tempera paint
Nylon fishing string
"Jingle" bells
Scissors

Large nail and hammer
Cotton balls
White glue
White paper
Black permanent marker



How To Make It:

1. Cut the nylon string in various lengths. Each wind chime will need four pieces approximately 12, 10, 8 and 6 inches in length.
2. Use the nail to punch four holes through both sides of the cardboard tube, spacing the holes evenly along the length of the tube.
3. Use the hammer and nail to punch one hole in each end of the four tongue depressors. Attach a nylon string to one end of each tongue depressor. Pull the other end of the string through a hole in the cardboard tube and tie a knot. Now thread a nylon string through the eye of a jingle bell and tie to the bottom of the tongue depressor. Repeat for each depressor. Use the tempera paint to paint each of the tongue depressors a different color of the rainbow.
4. Glue on cotton balls to completely cover the cardboard tube so it will appear to be a cloud. Print the Bible verse on a piece of white paper and glue to the cotton-covered tube. Attach a piece of string to the top of the tube for hanging.
