

## What's in a name?

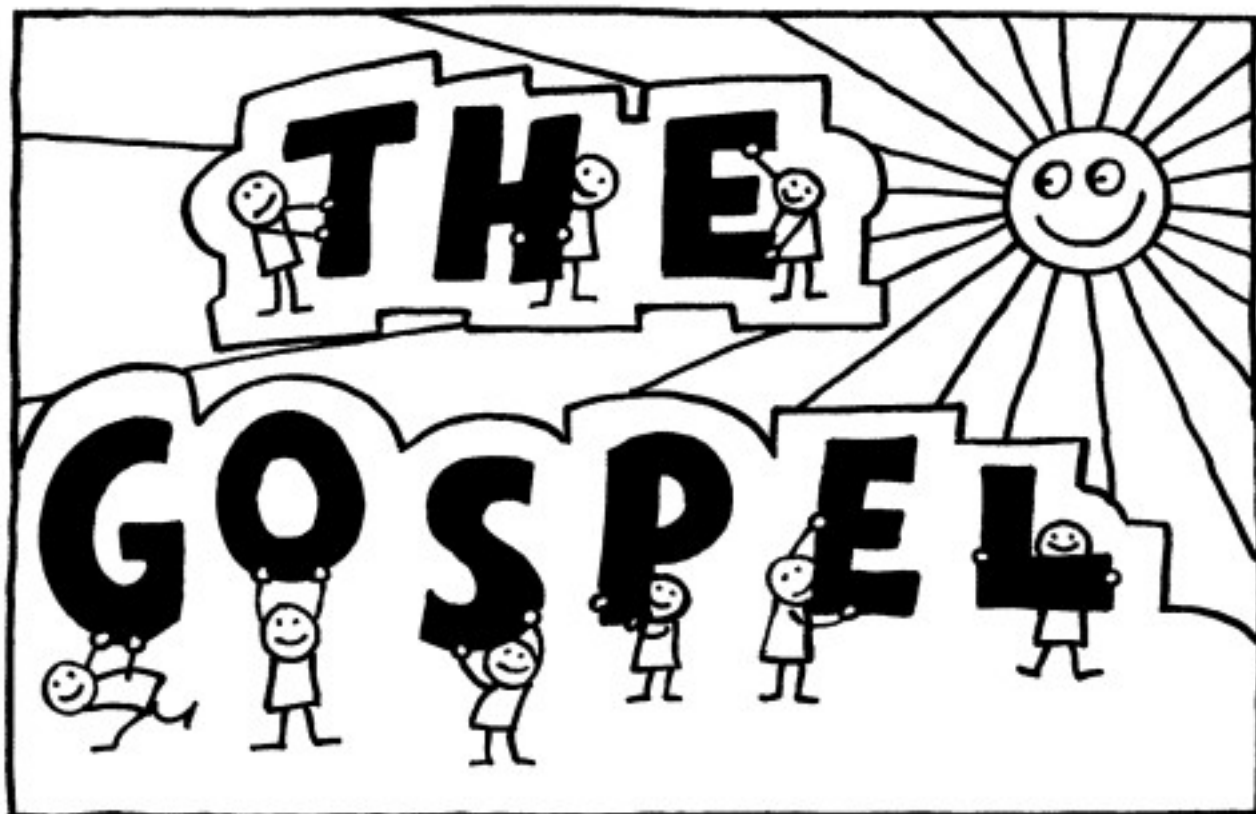
You probably know that Bible names always have some other meaning. For example "Dan" means "judge", and "Daniel" means "God is judge".

The names of the people listed from Adam to Noah all have a meaning, which are as follows :

Adam = Man. Seth = Appointed, Enosh = Mortal. Kenan = Sorrow. Mahalalel = Blessed God. Jared = Shall come down, Enoch = Teaching, Methuselah = His death shall bring. Lamech = The despairing, Noah = Rest, comfort.

If you put all the meanings of these names together to make a sentence, you have the gospel! God cleverly hid the gospel in the names because He wrote the Bible, and He wanted us to find these treasures hidden in His Word so we would have faith in its accuracy.

Here is the sentence made from the names : "Man (is) appointed mortal sorrow; (but) the blessed God shall come down teaching (that) his death shall bring (the) despairing rest."
